I kēia lā, e ‘olu‘olu i ka mea i loa‘a iā ‘oe — ka mea‘ai a me ka lole — a ua ‘oi aku kou waiwai ma mua o ka mea nona nā mea a pau akā ‘a‘ohe Akua. ‘O ka ‘olu‘olu, ‘a‘ole ia ka loa‘a nui; ‘o ia ka pono ‘ole i kekahi mea ‘ē a‘e ma waho ona.)

E ka Haku, ‘o ‘oe ke Akua nona ka mana akua i hā‘awi mai ia‘u i nā mea a pau e pono ai i ke ola a me ka haipule, ma ka ‘ike ‘ana i ka mea i kāhea mai ia‘u. No laila, ‘a‘ole au e noi ana i kekahi ikaika āu i ho‘āna ai, akā e noi ana au i ke kōkua e ho‘ohana pono i ka ikaika āu i hā‘awi mua mai ia‘u. A‘o mai ia‘u i kēia lā e ho‘oma‘ama‘a ia‘u iho i ka haipule, ‘a‘ole ho‘i e ho‘okau i ko‘u ikaika a pau i ke kino, ka mea i li‘ili‘i ka pono e loa‘a mai. Kōkua mai ia‘u e hele i mua o kou alo a ho‘opōmaika‘i iā ‘oe, e like me ko ‘Enoka hele pū me ‘oe; a mai ‘ae mai ia‘u e mālama wale i ke ‘ano waho o ka haipule me ka hō‘ole ‘ana i kona mana. E hā‘awi mai ia‘u i pu‘uwai ‘olu‘olu, i ‘olu‘olu ai au i ka ‘ai a me ke kapa komo, no ka mea, he waiwai nui ka haipule me ka ‘olu‘olu. E ho‘opakele mai ia‘u i ke aloha kālā, a me nā kuko e kaua ana i ka ‘uhane. A no ka mea e malo‘o ana ke aloha o ka nui o nā kānaka, e kōkua mai ia‘u e ho‘omau a hiki i ka hopena, ‘a‘ole ho‘i e lilo i mea mahana wale — i ‘ole au e like me kekahi kumulā‘au nona ka hua e mae ana, akā e like me kekahi e hā‘ule ‘ole ana loa, a i hā‘awi ‘ia mai ai ia‘u ke komo ‘ana me ka welina waiwai i loko o kou aupuni mau loa. No ka mea, he mea huna nui ka haipule: ua ‘ike ‘ia mai ‘oe ma ke ‘ano kanaka; e ho‘ohaipule mai ia‘u i loko ou. Āmene.
