HUA’ŌLELO HO’OMAKA

‘A’ole na’e he mana’o wale nō ke aloha; he hana nō ia. I ka ‘ōlelo kahiko, ‘elua ‘ōlelo. ‘O ka mua, ‘o chesed (H2617, mercy): ke aloha e kahe mai ana mai loko mai o ka berita — he lokomaika’i i ho’opa’a ‘ia i ka ‘ōlelo ho’ohiki, e mālama ana i ka mana’o’i’o. ‘O ka lua, ‘o racham (H7356, tender mercies): ke aloha hohonu e kahe iho ana mai ka mea nui a i ka mea li’ili’i, e like me ka makua kāne i kāna keiki. Mai ke Akua mai nō ke aloha a pau e kahe mai ai. Ua hō’ike mua ‘o ia i kona aloha iā kākou, a ke noi mai nei ‘o ia iā kākou e hō’ike aku i kēia aloha kekahi i kekahi; a i ko kākou hana ‘ana pēlā, no ia lā a no Kristo ka nani, ‘a’ole no kākou. He aloha ho’ōla kona aloha. Ua lawe mai ‘o ia iā Lota mai ke ahi mai. Ua mālama ‘o ia iā Iakoba, ka mea i kūpono ‘ole i ka hapa li’ili’i loa o ia aloha. A ke kani mai nei kēia mana’o ma o ka Salamo a pau: e mau ana kona lokomaika’i ā mau loa aku. Ho’okahi wale nō ke kumu o kona aloha a pau — ‘o ia ke ho’ōla: ‘a’ole ma nā hana a kākou i hana ai, akā, e like me kona aloha, ua ho’ōla mai ‘o ia iā kākou. E ‘imi pono ‘oe i kēia mea.

PEHEA KA BERITA HOU I WEHE HOU AKU AI IA MEA: KE ALOHA I HŌ'IKE 'IA IĀ LOTA NO KA MEA O 'ABERAHAMA (KINOHI 19:29) UA WEHE NUI 'IA I LOKO O KRISTO — 'O KE AKUA, KA MEA WAIWAI I KE ALOHA, UA HO'ĀLA PŪ IĀ MĀKOU ME IA ('EPESO 2:4-5). UA LILO KE ALOHA BERITA I ALOHA HO'ŌLA NO NĀ MEA A PAU.
